Updates (June2016-Aug2016)

ACTIVITIES:

Plantation Program:

- We planted 200 plants in William Booth Junior College with the help of NCC cadets in Bapatla on 5th July.
- We planted 200 plants in Patel Nagar on 3rd July.
- We planted plants near B.Pharmacy College on 15th July.
- We participated in the Plantation Drive, conducted in Bapatla, by Bapatla Municipality, on 29th and 30th July.

Health Camp:

- We volunteered for the Health Camp conducted by GBR Foundations in Ravi gardens on 5th April. 2800 patients attended the health camp.
- We volunteered for the Health Camp conducted by GBR Foundations in Ravi gardens on 7th August. 2300 patients attended the health camp.

Village Camp:

❖ MaruproluvariPalem:

1. Our volunteers (about 20 members) went to MaruproluvariPalem and conducted survey on 1st and 2nd July. Problems we identified over there are:

- Child marriages.
- Education facilities are being provided up to 8th class only, and for higher studies they need to go to Bapatla, so parents are not willing to send their children (girls) to Bapatla.
- No proper facilities for Bathrooms.
- Parents addicted to Alcohol Consumption, effecting their livelihood.

- Old people are having health problems like B.P, Diabetes etc.
 - Migration became a major problem for the education of their children. ➤ Economical problems affecting education of their children.
2. From July 8th our volunteers (about 10 members) went to this village, conducting classes to primary and secondary school students (5th to 8th) after that we are interacting with villagers.

Epurupalem:

- From July 5th onwards every Tuesday and Friday our volunteers (about 7 members) went to ZPHS Boys school, Epurupalem, clarifying doubts for 8th and 9th class students.

❖ Vedullapalli:

- From July 29th our volunteers are conducting tuitions to the students thrice in a week.

Physically Challenged School (PCS):

- From July 4th our volunteers are teaching basic knowledge about computer in physically challenged school, Vedullapalli, thrice a week.

Career Guidance:

- On July 23rd career guidance training program was conducted by Nirman organization. They trained us how to interact with the children.

On August 7th some of our girl volunteers interacted with the students of Girl's Welfare School, Bapatla

- On August 26th our volunteers (about 15 members) conducted a session about career guidance for 10th class students ZPHS Boys School, Epurupalem.

Independence Day celebrations:

- On August 15th our volunteers celebrated Independence Day in Maruproluvaripalem.
