- 1. The Students of R10 & R14 regulations who completed their four year B.Tech. and having <u>only one backlog subject</u> may appear for the Make-up test provided the student has already secured pass mark (24) in the <u>recent attempt</u> (November/December 2019) of the external examination of that particular subject.
- 2. The Make-up test will be conducted for 40 marks (8 x 1M, 2 x 16M) in Mid examination format and the marks obtained will be considered as final subject to a  $\underline{\text{maximum of 16 marks}}$ .
- 3. The make-up test will be conducted on <u>11.03.2020</u> (Wednesday) at Exam section **HALL 9 02.30 PM to 04.00 PM**.
- 4. The student has to apply to appear for the test by paying a fee of Rs. **1000/-** and submit the application by **06.03.2020** along with a letter of request indicating the genuineness of his/her candidature to be eligible for the make-up test with **necessary proof**.
- 5. The application should be recommended by the concerned HOD and approved by Principal.
