Training and Capacity Building and Student Support for Internship

This Terms of References (hereinafter referred to as ToR) is made on this.....30th.....day of the month ofJune..... in the year2021..... by and between the Bapatla Engineering College (BEC), (Autonomous), G.B.C. Road, Mahatmaji Puram, Bapatla, Guntur District, Andhra Pradesh [hereinafter called FIRST PARTY] on the ONE PART and the North Eastern Space Applications Centre (NESAC), Umiam, Meghalaya having its Office at Umiam, Ri-Bhoi District, Meghalaya 793103 [hereinafter called SECOND PARTY], an autonomous organisation of Department of Space, Govt. of India on the OTHER PART and (who for the purpose of this ToR are hereinafter collectively referred to as the parties).

WHEREAS the “First Party”, an autonomous college affiliated to Acharya Nagarjuna University, Guntur, Andhra Pradesh which offers B. Tech. Programmes in 8 branches of Engineering- Civil, Computer Science, Electronics and Communications, Electrical and Electronics, Mechanical Engineering, Electronics and Instrumentation, Chemical Engineering and Information AND WHEREAS the “Second Party” is involved in the research and applications of Space Sciences and Technology in various fields including agriculture, hydrology, atmospheric sciences, satellite communications, UAV remote sensing, GIS, urban & regional planning support etc.

The parties, having discussed fields for collaborative activities like incubation, training & capacity building and student support for internship and considered it expedient to agree in writing the cooperation in above activities.





Between Bapatla Engineering College (BEC) and North Eastern Space Applications Centre (NESAC) for collaborative activities in research & development, incubation, training and capacity building and student support for internship at no cost to NESAC.

Article 1. Scope

1.1 The First party was established in 1981 with a vision to impart quality technical education but the use of space technology in R&D activities is very much limited at BEC and wish to enhance it with support and collaboration with NESAC. Taking the requirements of the First party, it is proposed to collaborate between the parties in the following areas of mutual benefit:

- To organize collaborative Training Programs to the staff & students of the First party and to the employees of the Second party in Technology and Management.
- To provide internship for students of the First party.
- To engage students of the First party in development work by involving them in short term projects by the Second party.

Article 2. Publication and use of name, logo and official emblem

2.1 Both the Parties shall observe the following provisions regarding publication:

- a. The use of name, logo and/or official emblem of the parties on any publication, document and/or paper will require prior permission of both participants. It may however, be ensured that the official emblem and logo is not misused.

Article 3. Entry into effect, modification and termination

3.1. This Term of Reference shall become effective on the date it is signed by the parties and shall be valid for 2 (two) years without any financial implications to both the institutions. Cost for any activity of interest will be worked out specifically for that activity as per the actual under prevailing rules and regulations of both the institutions. Both parties shall review the status of the Term of Reference at the end of period to determine any modification, renewal or extension. This Term of Reference may be amended by mutual written agreement and may be terminated at any time by either party upon written notification signed by the competent authority of the party initiating termination. Such notification must be given to the other party at least three months in advance from the effective date of termination.

3.2 No amendment or modification of the Term of Reference shall be valid unless the same is made in writing by both the parties or their authorized representatives and specifically



stating the same to be amendment of the Term of Reference The modifications/changes shall become part of the Term of Reference and shall be effective from the date on which they are made/ executed, unless otherwise agreed to.

Article 4 Legal Relationship

4.1 This Term of Reference shall be construed as a statement of purpose to promote a genuine and mutually beneficial cooperation between the Parties. Nothing in this Term of Reference shall be constructed to create any legal relationship between the Parties.

Article 5 Settlement of dispute/Termination

5.1 Any dispute, controversy, or claim arising out of or in relation to this Term of Reference, including the validity, invalidity, breach or termination thereof, shall be settled by the Parties amicably through mutual consultations and negotiations within thirty days from the receipt of letter/notice by the aggrieved party. Decisions taken jointly by Principal, BEC & Director, NESAC will be the final and conclusive.

This Term of Reference has been executed in two originals, one of which has been retained by the First party and the other by the Second party.
