NOTICE (Special Make-up Test - Amendment to R14 Regulations)

- 2. The make-up test will be conducted on 19.11.2021 (Friday) at Exam section HALL 1 02.00 PM to 04.00 PM.
- 3. The student has to apply to appear for the test by paying a fee of Rs. 1000/- and submit the application by 15.11.2021 along with a letter of request indicating the genuineness of his/her candidature to be eligible for the make-up test with necessary proof.
- 4. The application should be recommended by the concerned HOD and approved by Principal.
