COE appraised the members regarding completion of academic year 2020-21 and the status of issue of certificates to the outgoing students. ANU has released Provisional certificates to the students. Original degree certificates to the regular students and provisional certificates to the supplementary students are yet to be released. The academic year 2021-22 started with 6-12 weeks delay for various odd semesters.

- 1. The class work and internal assessment tests are being conducted in offline mode as per our regular practice as zero COVID cases are reported for the last 3-4 months and all the students are vaccinated in various drives conducted in the campus.

- 6. Valuation of semester end answer sheets shall be evaluated as per our examination policy. Supplementary answer scripts will be sent for external evaluation.

Meeting convened by the Convener Dr. J. S. Rao, COE at COE office

COE appraised the members regarding delay of even semester end exams of academic year 2020-21 due to COVID 2^{nd} wave lockdown conditions. Based on the instructions from the Principal and guidelines issued by ANU / UGC / AICTE, the following are to be planned to complete academic year.

- 1. Balance syllabus for all semester students is completed by Online teaching mode through our existing Microsoft Teams. Internal assessment exams are to be completed through online mode.
- 2. 8th, 6th and 4th semester end exams are to planned for offline mode from 1st July 2021 onwards. It has been decided to conduct 8th semester exams in 2 phases (i.e. CE, EE & ME branches in the morning session and balance branches in the afternoon session in order to minimize the gathering and maintain social distance.
- 3. Hall tickets to the students are to be issued in the examination halls on the first day of examination by the respective department coordinators.
- 4. For semester end examinations choice shall be increased for this semester also and the same (pattern) shall be communicated to students in advance.
- 5. Re-examination to the students will be allowed only for the affected students with the submission of COVID positive certificate. For the students having symptoms or any family member suffering with COVID, a separate room shall be arranged with all necessary COVID precautions to write the examination in an isolated place.
- 6. Seating arrangement shall be with minimum 5-6 ft distance between any two students.
- 7. The semester end examinations tentative schedules to be prepared and communicate to students.
- 8. Many final year students got placements and companies agreed to give joining date based on college authorized course completion certificate. Hence after result declaration Y17 batch students data is to be updated on priority basis.
